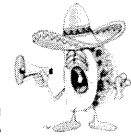

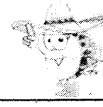

- 1) Conjugate the verb into the "yo" form of the present tense.
- 2) Drop the "o".
- 3) Add the "opposite" tú ending.

For ar verbs add ES
For er/ir verbs add AS
Pronouns for before the command.
Irregulars are SIDES and don't end in O.

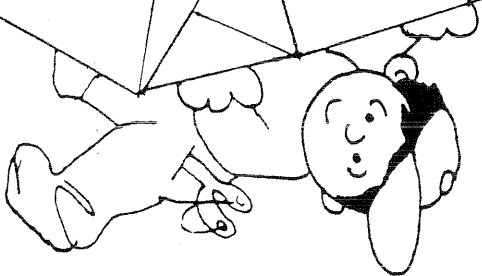
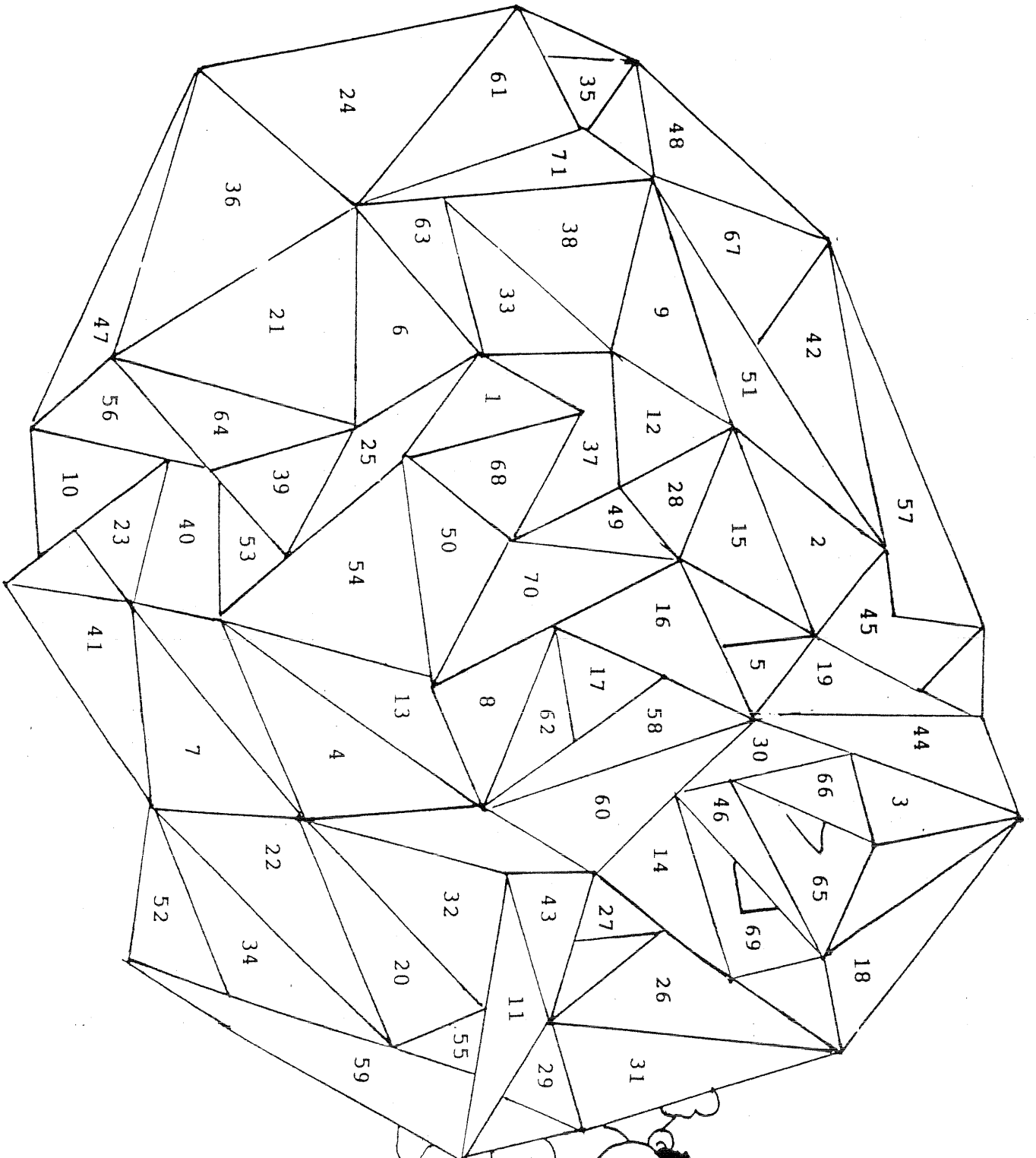
